Jury getting Michael Jackson's doctor's case

As of this writing, the prosecution and defense have rested their cases in the involuntary manslaughter trial of Dr. Conrad Murray.

As suspected, the defense mounted a vigorous campaign of "blaming the victim" by providing evidence that Jackson may have self-administered a lethal dose of Propofol to himself, which caused his death.

In contrast, the People's case was rather straightforward. Dr. Murray, as any physician, owed his patient a particular standard of care. Regardless of whether Jackson self-administered the lethal dose, the fact that Dr. Murray was even administering such drugs outside of a clinical setting was so far below the standard of care as to warrant a finding that he committed involuntary manslaughter.

As I previously have written, the facts that the jury must resolve are whether Dr. Murray caused Michael Jackson's death while (1) in the commission of an unlawful act, not amounting to felony; or (2) in the commission of a lawful act which might produce death, in an unlawful manner, or without due caution and circumspection.

The key for the jury, therefore, will be causation. In other words, at the end of the day, what caused Michael Jackson to die? And does it matter whether or not Jackson self-administered a lethal dose of Propofol?

Under California law, and unfortunately for the defense's theory, it does not matter what Jackson did, even assuming he swallowed or injected himself with additional Propofol. As has been established at trial and undisputed by the defense, the fact that Murray was administering the drug outside of a hospital or clinical setting, did not call 911 immediately, and did not reveal to other professionals that Jackson had Propofol in

his system all require a finding of guilt. Almost certainly the prosecution will argue in its closing that Jackson would have died anyway regardless of any additional self-administered Propofol.

Still, the jury could simply disregard the law and find him not guilty, or the jury could hang (not find a unanimous verdict). So-called "jury nullification" has a long history in American jurisprudence. Although it is unknown how frequent such nullifications occur because jurors generally are reluctant to discuss their reasoning after trial, there have been occasions when, presented with a particularly sympathetic defendant, juries have refused to find the defendant guilty. For example, in "mercy killing" cases jurors have sometimes declined to find the defendant guilty of the conduct charged under the circumstances.

But that is not the case here. While Dr. Murray has many redeeming qualities, at the end of the day a jury is not likely to find him so sympathetic so as to refuse to find him guilty despite their oaths to follow the law. Still the deliberation process will not be a short one. Jurors in high-profile cases have become acutely aware of how their conduct will be viewed by the public and media, and accordingly, will be even more diligent than perhaps otherwise in reviewing the evidence.

My educated guess is that a guilty verdict will be reached by mid next week.
